Chester-based Anne Duchess of Westminster's Charity is hosting the day on 11 November which will help raise vital funds for the Animal Health Trust (AHT).

The Animal Health Trust, based in Suffolk, works nationally and internationally to fight disease and injury in animals through research, clinical care and education. Established in 1942, the veterinary research charity develops new diagnostic tests, treatments and vaccines to help thousands of animals. Nearly all horses, dogs and cats in the UK will have benefitted from its work.

This is the 10th Race Day the Anne Duchess of Westminster's Charity has generously sponsored. This year's event is a particularly important fundraising event for the AHT as all the money raised from the day will directly fund its work.

Dr Mark Vaudin, Chief Executive of the AHT, said: "We are delighted to be the benefitting charity of the Anne Duchess of Westminster's Charity. The charity has supported a number of our key research programmes in recent years, and, as we receive no government funding, it is support like this that enables us to progress veterinary medicine and make such a difference for horses, dogs and cats in the UK and across the world.
