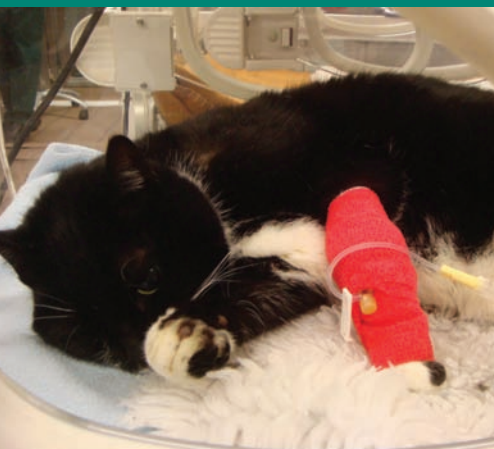


What is the Animal Health Trust?

The Animal Health Trust is an independent registered charity; a centre of excellence dedicated to improving the health and welfare of dogs, cats and horses. We aim to further the understanding of diseases in animals through scientific research and clinical care.

Employing over 200 scientists, vets and support workers, we have two clinics – one for dogs and cats and one for horses – and provide specialist referral services to the veterinary profession.

Disease and injury are the biggest threats to the health of our pets, and it is our aim to reduce unnecessary suffering as much as we can.



Our major breakthroughs in research and clinical advancement include:

- Development of vaccines against diseases including distemper, influenza and hepatitis
- Pioneering anaesthesia and surgical techniques
- Advanced methods of cataract surgery and treatments of eye disease
- Development of a diagnostic blood test to screen for Strangles in horses
- Numerous DNA screening tests for canine inherited genetic diseases in a number of breeds.

Scientific Excellence

At the Trust, we develop new technology to improve diagnosis, prevention and treatment of inherited, infectious and non-infectious diseases.

Our research teams and clinical staff work closely together to ensure that we are able to offer the best possible treatment and care. We share our finding with vets internationally to benefit companion animals all around the world.

Clinical Care

Our world class vets have a wealth of expertise and experience in a range of disciplines. These include anaesthesia, oncology, ophthalmology, neurology, dermatology, soft tissue surgery, internal medicine, diagnostic imaging, orthopaedics and lameness.

Every year, over 4,000 cases are referred to us from all over the UK. These are all advanced or very complex cases which cannot be managed in general practice.
